



Local procedures

1. Briefings

General and safety briefing will be held 10th June at 19.30. Daily briefing will be at 10.00 in I-hangar.

2. Use of Flarm

Flarm is mandatory in each competing glider.

3. Documents required in registration

Certificate of third party insurance (minimum amount is SDR 1.500.000) and a valid barograph trace. Documents can be sent in advance via e-mail to rayskala.masters@gmail.com. The validity of pilot and glider is proved by a signature of the pilot during registration.

4. Gridding

Grid order will be distributed each morning from the competition office.

5. Checking of glider's mass

Checking of glider's mass before take-off is done randomly at the grid.

6. Frequencies used during the competition flights

The competition frequency of 122.650 MHz shall be used at least until leaving the launching zone and on the final glide 10 km or less from the finish circle. During the contest flight frequency of 122.750 MHz shall be used.

7. Information of start time

Information of start time to competition officials is not required.

8. Information of outlandings

Information of outlandings shall be done to competition office via crew members or directly to the competition office, phone number will be distributed later.

9. Finish ring

Finish ring of 3 km will be used. Minimum height for crossing the finish ring will be 274 m (MSL), which is 150 m above the Räyskälä airfield elevation.

10. Landing procedures

After crossing the finish ring, the pilot must land according to instructions given in the daily briefing.

11. Downloading of IGC-file

The pilot must download the IGC-file via the competition website within 30 minutes after landing.

12. Protests

Protest fee is 100 €.

13. Prize giving

Prize giving ceremony will be arranged as soon as possible after the last competition flights.
